Day care and childminding: Guidance to the National Standards

If possible, child care classes should include the same group each day, and the same child care providers should remain with the same group each day. If your child care program remains open, consider creating a separate classroom or group for the children of healthcare workers and other first responders.

This guidance builds upon the Alberta Health Services Health and Safety Childcare Guidelines, which all child care operators are required to follow. Occasional day care provision for children under 12 years is that which is provided in particular premises for less than 6 days per year. This means occasional day care may be provided in a commercial setting i.e. a hotel, less than six times in a one year period.
