Any patient who is experiencing symptoms of diabetes such as polyuria, polydipsia, or unexplained weight loss should be screened for diabetes, especially if they are obese or overweight (BMI > 25 kg/m2). Asymptomatic adult patients should be tested at any age if they are overweight or obese and have an additional risk factor for diabetes.
