After World War II Beckett began to write in French, a language he felt was better suited than English to his vision of literature. Although he finished En attendant Godot in 1946, the play was rejected by six Paris publishers before its publication in this 1952 first edition of 2500 copies. “The date of its first [Paris] performance—Jan. 3, 1953—would be pricked out in gold in the annals of the stage...There is something of everyone in this play, and something of everywhere, too.
